Interns must have served in some capacity under a local church in the past. Interns must display godly character and a good daily devotional lifestyle. Interns must be willing to follow instructions given by team or organizational leaders. Interns must be willing to grow/ step out in their abilities, gifts/talents during the internship. Interns must be willing to be flexible while working with others.

Responsibilities of Interns:

Serve under the Hip Hope International team. Fulfill weekly assignments (which will be disclosed to you, prior to the official start of the internship). Some administrative work may be required. Interns must be willing to work 10-20 hours a week.
