Intern must be willing to follow instructions given by team or organizational leaders. Intern must be willing to grow/ step out in their abilities, gifts/talents during the internship. Intern must be willing to be flexible while working with others.

Responsibilities of Interns:

Serve under a Hip Hope International team. Fulfill weekly assignments (which will be disclosed to your team leader). Some administrative work may be required. Must be able to work 10-15 hours a week.
